Am I Eligible to Participate in the Merit-based Incentive Payment System (MIPS) in the 2022 Performance Year?



MIPS eligible clinician types:

Physicians (includes doctors of medicine, osteopathy, dental surgery, dental medicine, podiatric medicine, and optometry; osteopathic practitioners; and chiropractors (with respect to certain specified treatment, a Doctor of Chiropractic legally authorized to practice by a State in which he/she performs this function)), Physician Assistants, Nurse Practitioners, Clinical Nurse Specialists, Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists, Clinical Psychologists, Physical Therapists, Occupational Therapists, Qualified Speech-Language Pathologists, Qualified Audiologists, Registered Dietitians or Nutrition Professionals, Clinical Social Workers,* Certified Nurse Midwives,* groups or virtual groups that include one or more of these MIPS eligible clinician types

Low-Volume Threshold Criteria for 2022:

- Bill more than \$90,000 for Part B covered professional services under the Physician Fee Schedule; AND
- See more than 200 Part B patients; AND
- Provide more than 200 covered professional services to Part B patients

To achieve QP status in 2022, you must:

- Receive at least 50% of Medicare Part B payments; OR
- See at least 35% of Medicare patients through and Advanced APM Entity

To achieve partial QP status in 2022, you must:

- · Receive at least 40% of Medicare Part B payments; OR
- See at least 25% of Medicare patients through an Advanced APM Entity.
