

Advanced Alternative Payment Model (APM) Incentive Payments for 2022

The following table provides information on the amount of Advanced APM incentive payments that were paid to eligible clinicians this year based on their participation in Qualifying APM Participant (QP) Performance Period 2020. In order to qualify for such incentive payments, an eligible clinician is required to meet certain thresholds of participation in one or more Advanced APMs. In Performance Year 2020, the Advance APM participation thresholds were 50 percent of total Medicare Part B covered professional services payments received or 35 percent of total Medicare patients seen.

To provide additional context, the table on the following page shows the average QP threshold scores in each of the Advanced APM models operating in QP Performance Period 2019, the most recent year for which we have the values calculated.

Key Insights

Average payment threshold scores for Advanced APMs tended to be close to or greater than the required 50% while most of the Advanced APMs had average patient threshold scores above the required 35%.
